Scrap Metal – *Steel, Metal Items, White Goods & Major Appliances*

Electronic Waste – *TVs, Computers, Monitors, Keyboards, Mice, Fax Machines, Scanners, Printers, VCRs, DVRs, DVD Players, Portable Digital Music Players, Digital Converter Boxes, Cable / Satellite Receivers, Electronic / Video Game Consoles*

Textiles – *Clothing (Tops, Sweaters, Dresses, Outerwear, Bottoms, Suits, Socks, Pajamas, Underwear), Footwear (Shoes, Sandals, Sneakers, Boots, Slippers), Accessories (Hats, Purses, Belts, Gloves, Ties, Scarves), Linens (Sheets, Blankets). Items may be ripped, stained, button missing, broken zipper but....must be clean, dry and odor free.*
