Textiles – Clothing (Tops, Sweaters, Dresses, Outerwear, Bottoms, Suits, Socks, Pajamas, Underwear), Footwear (Shoes, Sandals, Sneakers, Boots, Slippers), Accessories (Hats, Purses, Belts, Gloves, Ties, Scarves), Linens (Sheets, Blankets). Items may be ripped, stained, button missing, broken zipper but....must be clean, dry and odor free.
